



*Figure 1.* Durations and stimuli used during the different Monetary Incentive Delay Task phases per Loss and Neutral trials. The response phase was adjusted using the staircase procedure, independently per trial type. Correct responses decreased the response phase duration of the next trial of the same trial type by 50 ms, incorrect responses increased that response phase duration by 50 ms. In the Loss trials, incorrect/late responses were followed by “You lost money” during the outcome phase, while correct responses within the allowed response window led to a neutral outcome screen, “Money not affected”. During Neutral trials, the latter outcome screen was shown regardless of response correctness.
