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As a forum for the interchange of ideas arising from the study of archaeology, *ARC* welcomes relevant contributions from workers in any field. Articles should not normally exceed 2000 to 4000 words in length. The forthcoming theme for 7/2 is Women in Archaeology. Non-themed contributions of general interest are also welcome. Shorter presentations on topical subjects are invited for Commentary and General Perspectives, as well as comments on the previous issues. Unpublished manuscripts will not generally be returned unless accompanied by a stamped self-addressed envelope or International Postal Coupon. The editors will attempt to ensure, but cannot always guarantee, that copy edited versions of accepted manuscripts will be returned to authors before publication. Manuscripts should be clearly typed, double spaced, and follow the format of this issue. Manuscripts on discs are also welcome (preferably IBM PC-compatible). Illustrations should be A4 (210 x 297 mm) for reduction to A5 (148 x 210 mm). *ARC* has a policy of the non-sexist usage of language, and contributors are requested to conform to this policy. The editors are most willing to assist with any enquiries which arise on this point. A style sheet is available on request.

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
