Contemporary stamped calf over oak boards to 3 bands; brass clasps and catches. A rectangular central panel divided by triple fillets into lozenge and triangular compartments containing square stamps of a double headed eagle and lozenge stamps in a fleur de lis, heart, and tulip shaped flower. Above and below the central panel four oblong compartments containing circular stamps of a cinqfoil, lion rampant, stag, and 'Maria' scroll; the panel and compartments are formed by triple fillets which extend to the fore-edge where similar vertical fillets form with them other compartments containing the stamp of the double headed eagle, 'Maria' scroll, and an oblong stamp of conventional foliage; the fillets decorated at intervals with cinqfoils and free rosettes
