Vellum, $10 \times 7\frac{1}{4}$ in., 175 ff (out of 186), single column, 27-29 lines to a page. Written at Marbach Abbey, A.D. 1473 in a clear gothic hand, with headings in red, initials in red or blue, capitals in the text touched with red; on ff 2 and 5 an initial in colour, with conventional foliage filling and flourishing. Contemporary natural calf over wooden boards to 4 bands, blind tooled with an intersecting frame formed by a pair of fillets decorated alternately with lozenge stamps of a leopard and cuque foli; the panel so formed divided by diagonal fillets into lozenge and triangular compartments, the former containing a lozenge stamp of a spray of foliage; at the intersections a quatrefoil stamp. Brass seatings for 2 clasps and catches, the clasps mostly gone; three paper labels (xvii/xviii) on the spine, two bearing title and the other, at foot, a printed 'P'.

 Tabernacibus 1637 (probably of Berg-Zaberne, Saverne in
