Istud seruicium pro morte euitenda fecit d^{ns} papa Iohannes XII et constituit in collegio omnium cardinalium et concessit omnibus (qui) dictum officium sequentem audientibus uel dicentibus uere confessis et contritis cc et lx diei indulgencie et omnes qui istud officium sequentem audient debent portare per quinque dies continuatas in manibus candelam ardentem genibus flexis dum missam sequentem audiunt et tunc mors subitanea nocere non poterit. et hoc certum est quod probatum in anmiana¹ ciuitate et in partibus zaracenis.
