MISSAL of Sarum Use 17. Proper of Time, beginning imperfect after the loss of 16 leaves in the lesson (Dan. iii, 49-87) for Saturday in Ember Week of Advent. The first 2 leaves (96-7) of the Ordinary of the Mass, and the first leaf (105) of the Canon are lost. 104⁶ blank. Two leaves (124-5) have been cut out at Whitsun, and three leaves (129-31) from Ember Friday to the beginning of Corpus Christi. One leaf (152) is wanting from the Epistle (Heb. ix, 2-12) for Ember Saturday in September to the latter part of the Sequence (Jerusalem et Syon flet) in the Dedication of a Church. 154 blank; 155 cut out. 156. Proper of Saints, beginning imperfect after the loss of 1 leaf in the Sequence (Sacrosancta) for Andrew, and ending imperfect in the Sequence (Odas hae in die) for Katherine with the loss of 1 leaf. One leaf (162) is lacking from the Preface at the Blessing of the Candles to

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the Lesson (Luke ii, 22-32) at the Purification One leaf (169) is lost from the commemoration of Alexander, Evencus and Theodolus, Martyrs ^(Finding of the Cross) to the first Secret for Dunstan One leaf (174) is cut out at the end of the sequence (Eya gaudens) for Alban, Protomartyr to the versicle said at the Nativity only of John, Baptist. One leaf (185) is wanting following the rubric for the Vigil to the rubric Sequens dicitur quotidie per octabas for the Assumption of the B.V.M. One leaf (198) is lost from the Lesson (Apoc. v, 6-12) for the Vigil to the Sequence (Christo inclito) for All Saints 202 cut out 203. Common of Saints, beginning imperfect after the loss of 1 leaf with the Office for an Apostle 214. Ordinacio misse quotidiane beate virginis etc. 217. Votive Masses, ending imperfect in the Mass Pro benefactoribus vel salute amicorum with the loss of 8 leaves 227-234 cut out. 235. In a later hand a Mass of the Cross beginning imperfect 235^b. In another later hand Offices of the Visitation and Transfiguration 236, 237^b - 238^b blank
