Section 1 (arts 1, 2), 60-62 lines to a page, in two current xvcent. hands (changing at 78), the first with red headings and paragraph marks, the capitals in the text touched with red, and red capitals with filling and flourishing in purple or blue. Section 2 (arts 3, 4), 45-46 lines to a page, in another current xvcent. hand, with paragraph marks alternately in red and blue, the capitals in the text touched with red, and blue capitals with filling and flourishing in red. Section 3 (art. 5, an insertion), 53-58 lines to a page, in a minute xivcent. hand, the capitals not filled in. Section 4 (arts 6-12), 42 lines to a page, in xvcent. current hands (changing at 157, 175<sup>b</sup>, 176<sup>b</sup>, and 178<sup>b</sup>), the capitals not filled in. Section 5 (arts 13-17), 54-55 lines to a page, in a closely written xivcent. hand, with running titles, paragraph marks alternately in red and blue, and blue capitals with filling and flourishing in red.
