Ad celos trahit ad celos qui cuncta creauit. On r is: apud fenkal (=Finchale) / apud farne in pre(cut off). This points to Durham. Also on 8 <sup>a</sup> at top is a letter A which recalls their marks. But the book is too late to be in the Catalogues we have. A saying of S. Macarius follows. On 5 <sup>b</sup> the hymn Angelus ad uirginem – post hoc exilium. 6 <sup>a</sup> blank, on 6 <sup>b</sup> a poem: Reminiscens beati sanguinis. quem effudit amator hominis – Ut nos donet regalibus. in fine celi sedibus.
