Vellum, $14 \times 10\frac{1}{4}$ in., 361 ff. (out of 370), double columns, 55-62 lines to a page. Written in several hands of the \times^{11} cent., with red headings, capitals, ~~large~~ numbers, and running titles alternately in red and blue. Decorative initials in gold and colour, with conventional foliage filling; at 170^b a rougher style appears and continues to 261^b at which point the original work resumes and continues to the end. Historiated initials, vide infra.

does not appear to have been printed. This copy selects
but one distich (black) for each type (red), whereas
the original work gives several. Besides a number of
additions it differs from other copies in its last types;
most end with the two thieves on the Cross, one saved,
