Meyer p. 352 notices the MS and calls the miniatures 'assez médiocres', which is just. There are 27, one half page, the others set in the columns, and very sparse in the latter part of the book. They have frames of patterned blue or pink with a gold trefoil sprouting from each corner, and ground of trellised or patterned blue or red, or of plain gold.

1 Almost half page, in two unequal compartments. In a narrow one on $\underline{L}$ the Lover, nude, in bed under a gold cusped arch with ogival top. Blue ground with a pattern of roses. Next he stands clad in red in a gold doorway. The rest of the picture has green ground with daisy buds. The Lover in blue looks $\underline{R}$ to a battlemented building. Trees seen over the top. In the upper stage a row of small figures, seven in number, all seemingly women: the one on $\underline{R}$ is half nude. They are probably characters in the poem. The lower stage is plain masonry.
The page is bordered and has a fine initial and a greyhound pursuing a rabbit at bottom.
